- All issues identified during Step 3 resolved prior to on-site services arrival.
- Approval to create Organizational Unit for storage of Mac OS X data prior to Centrify being on-site.
- Individual with appropriate Active Directory permissions is available while service team on-site.
- All Change Control required for implementation of Centrify DirectControl must be approved prior to services team arriving on-site.
